

Privacy policy and Cookie policy

This Privacy policy and Cookie policy describe the rules for the handling of personal data and the use of cookies within the framework of an online shop <https://www.funwood.toys> run by K&U Group Ltd. based in Szczurawice, 46 Szczurawice Street, 63-440 Szczurawice, entered in the Register of Entrepreneurs of the National Court Register kept by the District Court in Poznan - Nowe Miasto i Wilda in Poznan, IX Commercial Department of the National Court Register under the KRS number 0000711118, NIP 6222811647, REGON 369061330.

§ 1

Definitions

For the purposes of this privacy policy, the terms listed below shall have the following meaning:

- 1) Administrator - engaged in an economic activity under the name of K&U Group Ltd. based in Szczurawice, 46 Szczurawice Street, 63-440 Szczurawice, entered in the Register of Entrepreneurs of the National Court Register kept by the District Court in Poznan - Nowe Miasto i Wilda in Poznan, IX Commercial Department of the National Court Register under the KRS number 0000711118, NIP 6222811647, REGON 369061330.
- 2) Shop - online shop available at the Internet address <https://www.funwood.toys>
- 3) User - every entity browsing or using the Website

§ 2

Personal Data

1. Every User may transmit its personal data to Administrator using the form such as order forms or forms of signing for newsletters available at the Website
2. The Administrator of the personal data submitted by the Users (pursuant to the Act of 29 August 1997 on the Personal Data Protection) is Administrator.
3. Personal data transmitted to the Administrator by the User are processed in the files kept by Inspector General for the Protection of Personal Data
4. Personal data transmitted to the Administrator by the User within the framework of the order form are processed to perform contracts for the supply of digital content via the Shop. Provision of the personal data by the User is voluntary, but necessary to perform the contracts for the supply of digital content between the User and Administrator.
5. Personal data transmitted to the Administrator by the User within the framework of signing for newsletter are processed in order to send the newsletter to the User. Provision of the personal data by the User is voluntary, but necessary for the User to sign for the newsletter.
6. Administrator guarantees the confidentiality of the personal data.
7. Personal data shall be collected and handled with due care and protected against unauthorised entry or use, and the processing is based on the terms and conditions described in:
 - 1) the Act of 18 July 2002 on provision of services by electronic means.

2) the Act of 29 August 1997 on personal data protection

3) the Regulation of April 29, 2004, by the Minister of Internal Affairs and Administration as regards personal data processing documentation and technical and organisational conditions which should be fulfilled by devices and computer systems used for personal data processing.

8. The User has the rights, specified in legal acts, referred to in paragraph 7 above, especially to:

1) have access to his personal data

2) have the right to demand completing, updating, correcting personal data, temporary or permanent stopping their processing or deleting them, if they are incomplete, outdated, incorrect or have been collected unlawfully, are no longer required for the purpose for which they have been collected.

§ 3

Cookies

1. Administrator uses Cookies- short text files containing the information recorded by the User's terminal equipment (for instance, computer, tablet, smartphone). Cookies can be read by the Administrator's IT System.

2. Administrator keeps Cookies on the User's terminal equipment and gain access to the information contained in Cookies for statistical purposes, marketing purposes (remarketing) and In order to ensure the proper functioning of the Shop.

3. Administrator hereby informs the User that there is a possibility that a web browser can be configured in such a way that it prevents Cookies from being stored on the User's terminal equipment. In such case, using/browsing the Shop by the User can be difficult.

4. Administrator hereby indicates that Cookies can be deleted by the User after being saved by the Administrator. This can be done by special functions of a web browser, dedicated programs or by using proper tools available in the User's IT system.

§ 3

Server logs

1. Using the Shop is related to transmission of requests to the server, where the Shop is kept.

2. Each request routed to the server is saved in server log files. The log files include e.g. the User's IP address, server date and time, information about a web browser and operating system.

3. Server logs are saved and stored on the server.

4. The data saved in the server logs are are not associated with the individual persons browsing the Site and they are not used by the Administrator to identify the User. The logs are only used as a material for the better administration of the Shop, and their content is not revealed to anyone, except the authorised persons administrating the server.
